




REMOVING A COMMITTEE






STEP 1: GO TO THE COMMITTEE YOU ARE LOOKING TO DEACTIVATE AND HIT EDIT




STEP 2: UNCHECK THE "ACTIVE COMMITTEE?" CHECKBOX AND HIT SAVE




STEP 3: GO THE APP LAUNCHER AND SELECT JOTFORM FROM THE DROPDOWN MENU




STEP 4: HIGHLIGHT THE "PORTAL ONLY COMMITTEE PREFERENCE FORM" AND HIT EDIT FORM




STEP 5: GO TO THE COMMITTEE YOU HAVE DEACTIVATED AND HITTHEX THAT POPS UP NEXT TO THE COMMITTEE




STEP 6: SCROLL TO THE TOP OF THE PAGE AND HITTHE JOTFORM LOGO








STEP 8: CLICK ONTHE OBJECT MANAGER TAB IN THE SETUP NAVIGATION




STEP 9: TYPE **CONTACT INTO** THE OBJECT MANAGER QUICK FIND BOX AND SELECT CONTACT




STEP 10: CLICK ON THE FIELDS & RELATIONSHIPS TAB IN THE CONTACT MENU




STEP 11: TYPE COMMITTEE PREFERENCE INTO THE FIELDS & RELATIONSHIPS QUICK FIND BOX AND SELECT THE COMMITTEE PREFERENCE FIELD



STEP 12: SCROLL DOWN TO THE VALUES SECTION AND FIND THE COMMITTEE YOU HAVE DEACTIVATED. HIT "DEACTIVATE" NEXT TO THE COMMITTEE NAME



STEP 13: RETURN TO THE AFDO APP BY HITTING THE APP LAUNCHER AND SELECTED AFDO FROM THE DROPDOWN MENU







THE COMMITTEE HAS NOW BEEN DEACTIVATED. NO ONE WILL BE ABLE TO JOIN THE COMMITTEE AND MEMBERS WILL NO LONGER SEE THE COMMITTEE IN THE AFDO COMMITTEE PORTAL. NOTE: THE AFFILIATION TO THE COMMITTEE WILL STILL SHOW ON THEIR CONTACT RECORD
